


This course runs along the old Tsukuba railway line, offering grand views of the peaks of Mt. Tsukuba. The majority of the route is geared toward bicycles and pedestrians. Designed for all cyclists including beginners, the course also features a number of rest areas using the remnants of old station buildings. There is also the Tsukuba hilly course along the railway line—making the experience incredibly rich-and-varied! It should be noted that cycling in springtime amongst the cherry trees is a truly magical experience.

Mt. Tsukuba Mt. Tsukuba, regarded as a symbol of Ibaraki

Prefecture, is known for its twin peaks, called the "male" (Nantai, 871 meters) and "female" (Nyotai, 877 meters). Visitors are treated in early spring to the plum blossoms, and to the colored leaves in the fall—and at all times to the spectacular view of the Kanto Plain from the summit accessible by ropeway and cable car. 


